The Coburg Bar - Chic, yet intimate, specializing in cocktails spanning three centuries, together with a rare selection of spirits and champagnes.

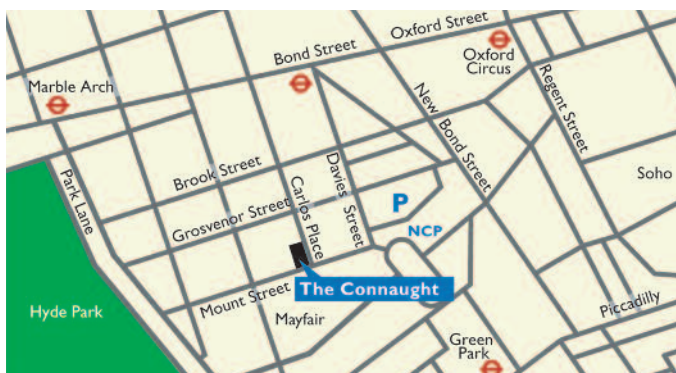

Directions by air

London Heathrow is the city's main airport, approximately 45 minutes' drive from the hotel. London is also served by Gatwick and London City Airports.

Directions by train

The nearest underground stations are Green Park and Bond Street, on the Piccadilly and Jubilee lines respectively. Victoria Station is 15 minutes by car, served by several main line underground links, as is the new St Pancras International Eurostar terminal, which takes 20 minutes by car.
